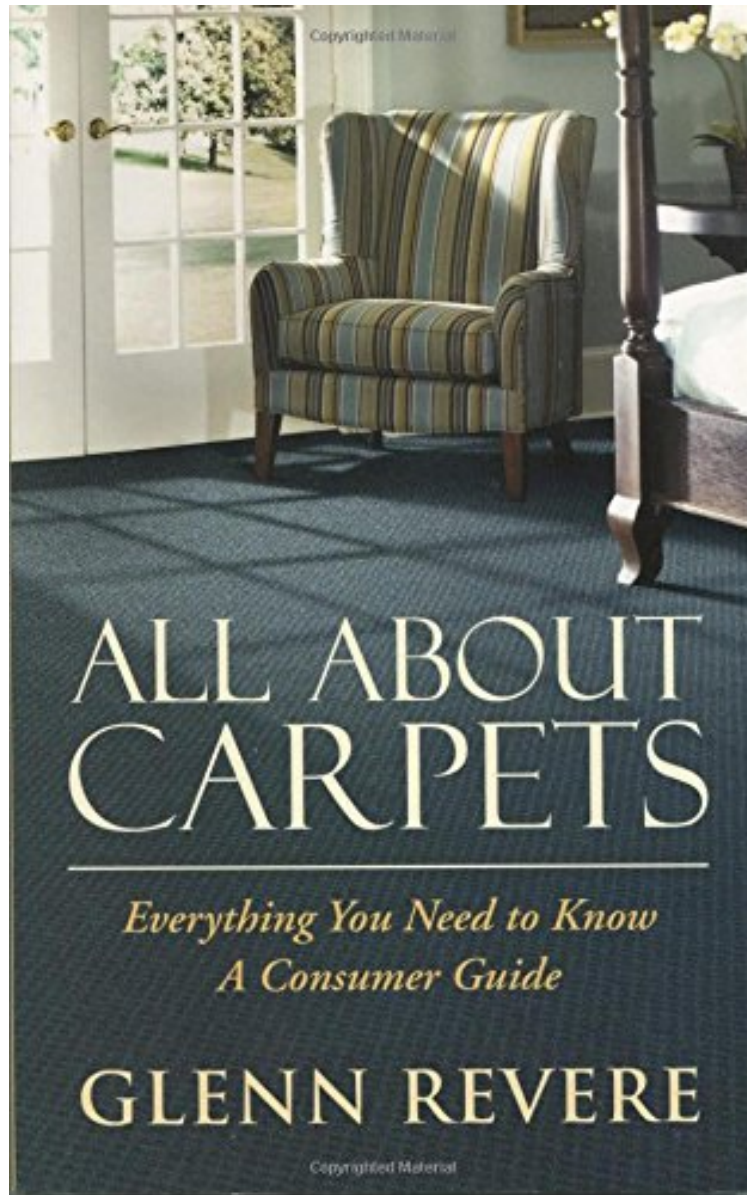

He even covers installation, and perhaps most helpful after purchasing is cleaning, something not to skimp on. We learned the hard way that pet odors do not come out with store brand cleaners, no matter how puffed up their advertising is. Hire a pro and get your carpet cleaned once every 2 years as Revere suggests. There is much, much more he covers, but I think you get the picture.
